Blend: 58% Barbera & 42% Sangiovese.

Tasting Notes:

Flavors and Aromas: A fruity and complex aroma intrigues the senses, presenting notes of wild strawberry, cherry, and cranberry, as well as pleasant notes lent by the French oak, including golden brown pie crust, vanilla, and a sprinkle of cinnamon. These flavors dance through to the finish.

Body and Structure: Smooth on the palate, with integrated tannin, substantial mouthfeel, and balanced acidity.

Pairings: Fresh pastas, roasted chicken, or veal scaloppini.

Details:

Amuleto, meaning “amulet” in Italian, is crafted exclusively for the Rubino Estates Wine Club. Combining two of the most popular Italian varietals, it’s our good luck charm. The fruit was lightly destemmed then meticulously sorted for optimum fruit purity. Our winemaker gently fermented this wine with hand punchdowns using a combination of specialized yeast strains. Aged in 57% new oak (100% French) for 20 months.
