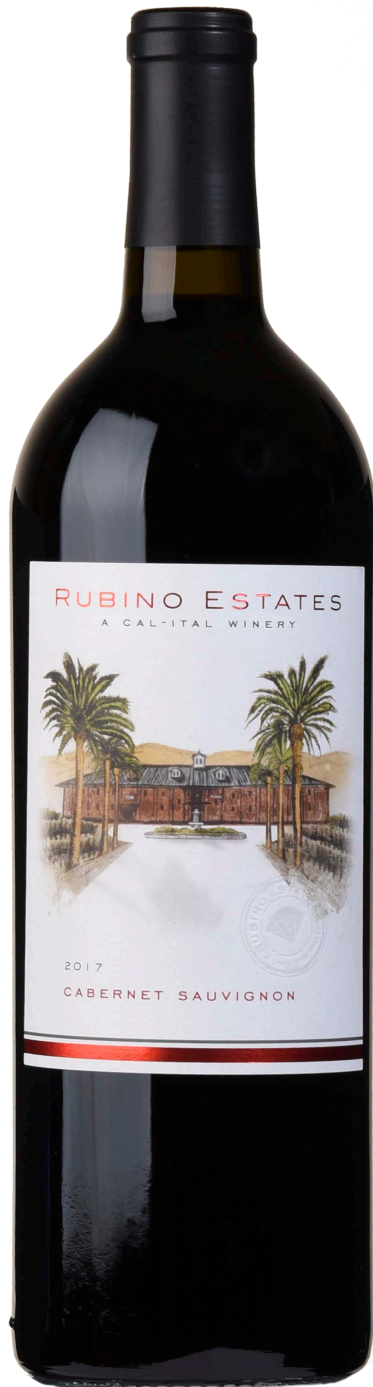

Tasting Notes:

Flavors and Aromas: Aromas of toasted oak, coffee, dried plum, cedar, and red fruit in the background. The flavors open up on the palate, with brooding dark fruits, including figs and black cherries, juxtaposed with bright red fruit.

Body and Structure: The tannins still have a small grip, and the wine has a very nice level of acidity with a very long finish. As the wine opens, floral notes join the complexity of the flavor.

Pairings: Simple meatballs, brisket, rosemary-pepper beef rib roast and zucchini gratin with tomato confit.

Details:

An Italian spin on the traditional Bordeaux classic. Lightly destemmed, then meticulously hand sorted for optimum fruit purity. Gently fermented with hand punchdowns, and fermented using several specialized yeast strains. Our Cabernet Sauvignon was aged in 70% new French oak for 19 months prior to bottling.
